USE LEVEL : 0.5 to 3.0 % (as per end-use requirements)

METHOD OF USE : By preparing a masterbatch

STORAGE : It is recommended to store this product at room temperature. At lower temperature, it may crystallize due to its inherent characteristics. The crystallization is reversible when heated and has no influence on application properties.
