THE CHILD WELFARE TRUST





We supported the trust in providing transportation to Dhanvantari School, which currently enrolls approximately 110 students in its ongoing educational program. These students come from Bhuj and neighboring villages, spanning a radius of approximately 30 kilometers daily.

Supporting a Residential Educational and Vocational Training Campus catering to children from Nomadic, De-Notified, and Marginalized Communities.

It will benefit approximately 1000 students once fully operational.

MALVI EDUCATIONAL AND CHARITABLE TRUST
